WHAT IS SUPER Y?

At the Super Y League, the goal is to provide clubs with an experience that is unparalleled in youth soccer. The Super Y League has a passion for player development. With a new Regional Scouting Series, partnerships with some of the leaders in youth soccer, experiences and professional staff, advanced player tracking, and offering the chance to compete for a North American Championship, the Super Y League is one of the strongest operated youth league in North America, allowing it to excel in national competition.

Player Evaluations for St. Mary's Soccer Super Y Teams

Players interested in playing Super Y will need to attend the tryout scheduled for January 21 at Leonard Hall and Miedzinski Park. Final tryout schedule, including age group and evaluation time will be published January 15. Teams will be formed per age group and gender based on adequate number of skilled players.

Summer Season

The summer season games are expected to run from June through mid August. Training sessions will be held 1x/week beginning the first week of June -the first week of August. All Super Y teams will be trained by the SMS Pro staff and their associated Coaches. Games 1x per week on average; a mixture of home and away games throughout the summer.

Championships

Super Y Nationals are held in Bradenton, FL, for divisional winners in early December 2018. It is a requirement for finalists to attend and is a strong venue for national exposure.

Teams & Cost

U11 and U12 Player fee of \$400/player paid to SMS as of February 28, 2018

U13 through U19 Player fee of \$425/player paid to SMS as of February 28, 2018.

U11/U12 teams will play 9 v 9 and support a roster up to 26 players to accommodate summer schedules

U13 – U-19 teams will play 11v11 and support a roster up to 26 players to accommodate summer schedules

Cost covers field rentals, uniforms, insurance, referees, coaching fees, and league fees.

Travel (transportation/hotel) fees during normal league play and Nationals are not covered.
